As with many organizations, the COVID pandemic has presented a unique and unprecedented set of challenges to our organization. As you know, back in March, we made the difficult decision to close for seven months. This has been hard on all concerned – volunteers, staff, guest families and our many wonderful supporters and partners throughout the community.

As you also may know, the public health response to the pandemic led us to cancel all of our popular in-person fundraising events this year. The loss of these critical revenue streams along with the loss of rental income all while sustaining our fixed costs, has had a major negative impact on the finances of the House. On a positive note, I am excited to tell you that as of October 13 the Mark Preece Family House has re-opened with a full set of COVID safety protocols and we are experiencing the return of our first families in the House again – what a wonderful sight!

Everyone associated with the House is excited to be back delivering on our purpose of providing a warm and welcoming safe harbour for families caught in the storm of a medical crisis. The need continues to be there and we are here, committed to serving families at a very difficult time.

I understand these are challenging times for many of us, however, if you are able to support the House with a financial donation your contribution <u>will</u> make a difference. We all look forward to the time when we can get together once again and have some fun in support of the House. Until then, best wishes to all for a safe and healthy holiday season!


### **Our Mission**


